

ASI Scandinavia

Adventist-laymen's Services & Industries

(ASI) is a membership-based organization of Seventh-day Adventist lay people who are enthusiastic about sharing Christ in the marketplace. ASI Scandinavia is part of a worldwide movement, comprised of supporting ministries, aspiring young people, professionals and business owners.

ASI's philosophy promotes a Christcentered lifestyle, where members seek to experience Christ's love in their own lives and share that love with the people they encounter in their everyday work and activities – hence ASI's motto. *Sharing Christ in the Marketplace.*

ASI history

ASI's history is rooted in Madison College, an Adventist self-supporting institution established in 1904 near Nashville.

Tennessee, USA, by E.A. Sutherland and Percy Magan. As Madison expanded, it began to plant satellite schools and institutions around the country. In 1947, under General Conference guidance, these self-supporting entities formed the Association of Seventh-day Adventist Self-Supporting Institutions, or ASI. At the time. ASI members were educational or health outposts. Over the years however, ASI membership began to include businesses and Adventist entrepreneurs and professionals. Thus, in 1979, to better reflect ASI's diverse membership, the organization's name was changed to Adventist-laymen's Services & Industries.

ASI Scandinavia was established in 2008, and is a member of ASI Europe.

- **Inspire and equip** lay people to be active in sharing Christ, focusing on the energy of young people and the entrepreneurism of professionals and business owners.
- **Q2** Encourage young people to reach their full potential in God by developing professional skills through missionary and vocational training, and higher education.




Chantal Tomlinson


Christian Karlsson

Between 6-8 of the pitches will be selected to be worked on during the workshop times.



Medical Assistance

In case of medical emergency, the emergency number in Sweden is 112.

Fire safety

A. In case of emergency alarm for the ones staying in the dorms, follow the green signs to gathering point number 1 - the "pancake" in front of the castle.


All the rooms and corridors are equipped with fire alarms.

Open fires of any kind (for example, lit candles) are prohibited in the dormitories or any other place.

B. In case of emergency alarm for the ones staying in the school or the library building, the gathering point is number 2 - the basketball field.

Extinguishers are available in all the corridors.
